Terrier Card: Your BU ID

The Terrier Card is the official Boston University student identification card. For new students, Terrier Cards are issued at the start of their first semester.

- Photo identification must be presented to receive a new Terrier Card. Valid identification includes a driver's license, state identification card, or passport.
- Terrier Cards are valid for on-campus identification only. For information on obtaining a new or replacement Terrier Card visit the Terrier Card website.
- Students can obtain their student ID card from the Terrier Card Office located in the George Sherman Union on the Lower Level.
- Students must bring a valid picture ID (Driver's License or Passport) in order to be issued their Terrier Card.
- Students will need to be registered for at least one class prior to being able to receive their Terrier Card.
