PIANO TECHNICIAN INTERNSHIP

(2 weeks, June 15-June 29, 2025)

Boston University Tanglewood Institute (BUTI) is recognized internationally as a premier summer training program for aspiring young musicians and is the only program of its kind associated with one of the world's great symphony orchestras. Under the guidance of distinguished professionals, and in the presence of the Boston Symphony Orchestra (BSO), students are immersed in an atmosphere of extraordinary music making fueled by high artistic standards, rigorous programming, and a rich legacy of learning and performance.

Responsibilities

This position works closely with and reports to BUTI's lead piano technician. This is an opportunity for developing piano technicians to develop their tuning skills within a real-world summer festival environment. Piano inventory includes older uprights, small grands, and concert instruments. Specific responsibilities include:

- Service pianos, performing repairs if needed
- Assist in tuning pianos
- Maintain a piano tuning and/or repair schedule for all pianos in studios, rehearsal rooms, classrooms, performance halls, and offices
- Perform emergency repairs and tuning as needed

Compensation includes housing, all meals, and a Tanglewood Lawn Pass for the summer. This is an unpaid internship.
