Prior to graduate school, Tiana was the Boston District Service Department Manager for SimplexGrinnell – a commercial provider of fire alarm, fire sprinkler, security, and other life safety/emergency services. She also served four years on active duty in the U.S. Army as an Air, Space, and Missile Defense Officer.
