

Notes on the data:

FY 2010 data present a snapshot of faculty salaries by school, rank and gender from the Provost's Office Faculty Information Database (ALFA) as of 10/30/09. The FY 2009 data are from 10/01/08. Only faculty with unmodified titles (both T/TT and NTT) on the CRC are included. If there are fewer than 4 faculty of a given rank and gender the salary data are not shown, although these salaries are included in the average calculations. These are 9 month salaries.

Please note that these data cannot be used to calculate average raises from year to year because the population of individuals in a given rank in a school changes as new appointments are made, faculty resign or are promoted to a higher rank and so on. Associate Professors are particularly problematic in this regard, as there is movement both into and out of this rank with each promotion cycle. The data in this table are calculated using the salaries of the individuals holding given ranks in each school on a single date.

In 2010 the female/male faculty salary ratios for the CRC overall are:

Assistant Professor: 0.98

Associate Professor: 0.93

Professor: 0.92
