





Postdoctoral Training Program for Global Health Innovations

Seeking Applicants for Innovative New Training Grant

We are currently seeking applicants for a Global Health training position on an NIH funded Global Health Innovation grant (PIs: Christine Wanke, MD and Honorine Ward, MD). One to two year position for motivated, experienced post-Masters student or postdoc from any relevant discipline (for example: Microbiology, Immunology, Engineering, Infectious Diseases, Economics, Environmental Health, Nutrition, or Public Health). Position will require working on a multidisciplinary team and all projects must have a translational (full spectrum of translation included) component. Position also requires travel to India as training time will be split between Christian Medical College (CMC) in Vellore, India and Tufts University and Tufts Medical Center in Boston. Benefits include NIH-based annual stipend commensurate with level of experience, healthcare benefits, and travel to CMC.





Applicants must:

- be US citizens or permanent residents
- have a doctoral or medical degree (PhD, DrPH, DVM, MD) or highly qualified candidate with a Masters Degree
- have some degree of prior global health experience
