## ACCELERATE YOUR CAREER WITH THE I-PHN FELLOWSHIP

The I-PHN Fellowship is a year-long paid fellowship for post-graduate students who aim to work in the international public health nutrition sector. This highly-competitive program will accelerate the careers of eight fellows through an intensive classroom and field-based curriculum in the management of international public health nutrition programs. Fellows will be trained by experts in the fields of international nutrition program management and humanitarian core competencies. At the end of the program, the eight fellows will be prepared to launch their careers as innovative leaders in international public health nutrition.

## TRANSITION SMOOTHLY FROM ACADEMIA TO THE FIELD

- \* An internationally based technical expert will mentor the fellow through the transition into their profession role in the field.
- \* A country-based mentor will help the fellow transition into living and working within the country's context and culture.
- \* When appropriate, the fellow will be paired with a member of the nutrition field team who will provide direction on the facilitation of program activities and sector coordination.

International field placement could include Cambodia, Democratic Republic of Congo, Kenya, Nigeria, South Sudan, and Uganda

### Eligibility

- ♦ Able to work in the United States
- ♦ Hold a graduate degree by June, 2016.
- ♦ Be able to make a one year commitment to the fellowship.
