Casey León served in Peace Corps in Puyo, Ecuador - a provincial capital in the Amazonian region of the country. She worked with the Ministry of Public Health and Department of Intercultural Health to improve medical services for indigenous patients in the provincial hospital. Her time spent with indigenous communities included flying in tiny planes deep into the jungle to land on machete-maintained airstrips, frequent spiritual cleansing by shamans, learning to shoot a blow gun, and more. Casey currently works for our neighbor, Boston Health Care for the Homeless.
