Below you'll find instructions on how to record your videos as well as the suggested framing and content.

# Purpose:

To share more widely how BU students are working with local governments and community-based organizations to advance important public service projects. MetroBridge will share these videos on the program's website and social media platforms.

# Format:

The format for the videos is a PowerPoint slide deck recorded with your narration. Instructions are accessible at this link - <u>How to Record a Slideshow with Narration</u> – and helpful screenshots are provided on the next page.

## Length:

Each video should be only one to two minutes long and no more than five slides.

### Suggested Content:

Introduce Yourself

1. Tell us your name, your degree program, the course you were in and the professor's name

### Overview of the Project Goals

- 2. Who was the MetroBridge partner?
- 3. What research question did the partner need help with?

### Describe Your Research

4. What activities/research did you conduct? (e.g., survey, interviews, data analysis)

### Key Findings

5. What are 1-2 highlights you found through your research?

### Recommendation/Conclusion

- 6. What was the most important recommendation you made to the partner (if applicable)?
- 7. What do you hope the partner will do with this information?

## How to Record a Slideshow with Narration:

#### Step One

Click the **Slide Show** tab, select the slide where you want the recording to begin, and then click **Record Slide Show**.

#### Step Two

Click End Show to stop recording.

A **Save** dialog box appears. Click **Yes** to save your recording, or **No** if you want to record it again.

#### Step Three (Save as a Video File)
