**SUBJECT:** Submitting Graduate Worker Pay Attestation for Previous Weeks of Unpaid Work

As you may know, the Boston University Graduate Workers Union (BUGWU) [voted on October 16](#) to ratify the University's [three-year contract offer](#) and end their strike.

You are receiving this email because you currently hold or have held a service-paid research or teaching position represented by BUGWU.

During the strike period, graduate students in salaried service positions were asked to complete a weekly attestation survey certifying their work effort so the University could pay those who chose to work during the strike. **Now that the strike has ended, it is no longer necessary to submit these weekly attestations.**
