Professor Dário Borim is Associate Professor and Chair of the Department of Portuguese at UMass Dartmouth. He holds a Ph.D. in Hispanic and Luso-Brazilian literature and linguistics from University of Minnesota, Twin Cities. He teaches graduate and undergraduate courses in the Portuguese language, Luso-Brazilian literature, cinema, theater, and music.
