

MINOR IN SPANISH

THE SPANISH MINOR REQUIRES SIX 4-CREDIT CAS LS COURSES IN LANGUAGE, LITERATURE, AND LINGUISTICS, NUMBERED 254 AND ABOVE

Students may take up to two 300-level Spanish language courses (chosen from CAS LS 306, 307, 308, 310, 311, 312, and 318) before moving on to higher levels.

- Native or heritage speakers of Spanish should enroll in LS 309 and a Hispanic literature course, or in two Hispanic literature courses, after consultation with an advisor

Up to four courses taken through Boston University's Study Abroad program in Madrid may count toward the minor.

All prospective student minors should seek advice and approval from a minor advisor to design a six-course program that is consistent with their individual background, interests, and goals. Contact Abby Robertson (abrobert@bu.edu) to request a minor advisor.
