- DO NOT place any protected health information (PHI) or confidential information in these bins

881 Shred Containers for Confidential Documents

- There are multiple Shred-It bin containers located throughout SHS
- ALL PHI must be placed in these containers, NOT the recycle bins
- The Shred bins are picked up every Wednesday at 881
- Shred-It Bin Locations:
 - Patient Services
 - Behavioral Medicine 1
 - Admin Office
 - Outside of the Lab
 - Units 1 & 2 Nurses Station
 - Beneath the staff mailboxes

Disposing of Batteries, Lightbulbs & Toner

- SHS has collection stations for batteries, lightbulbs and toner

- If any of these containers are full, send an email to shs-operations@bu.edu

Disposing of Food & Other Waste Materials

- Please do not place soiled food containers or liquids inside of the blue recycling containers in the custodial closet. BU Facilities will not remove the bins if these items are inside.
 - Plastic, paper, aluminum or metal materials must be cleaned before placing them into the recycling containers
- Cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed in the custodial room where the recycling bins are located. Do not leave them in the hallway.
- Anything that can be repurposed that you think someone could use (i.e., small desk items, lamps, heaters, etc.), please place it in the custodial room
- Large furniture items that need to be removed should be kept inside the office. A ticket needs to be submitted to <u>SHS-operations@bu.edu</u> to arrange a day and time for trucking to remove
