APPLICATIONS BEING ACCEPTED FOR 2025/2026 MIRIAM HURWITZ SCHOLARSHIP

The Boston University School of Social Work Financial Aid Office is pleased to announce that applications for the 2025/2026 **Miriam Hurwitz Scholarship** are now being received. The late Professor Hurwitz is a former member of the School of Social Work faculty who is remembered for her many contributions to family treatment. For 27 years, the Hurwitz family honored her legacy with the annual Miriam Hurwitz Memorial Lecture. In 2008/2009, the lectureship was converted into a scholarship fund that awards two \$4,000 scholarships annually to meritorious full-time social work students in financial need. Specifically:

- 1. The award can be used toward tuition and book costs for 2 **continuing full-time BUSSW students**. One-half of the scholarship is payable at the beginning of each of the final two semesters.
- 2. Students must have completed a minimum of 30 credits, have a minimum 3.25 grade point average, and have high need, as determined by the FAFSA.
- 3. Applicants must complete an application form and a one-to-two page, double-spaced essay sharing your thoughts on the following and how it relates to you:

Social work is deeply rooted in a commitment to a set of core values. Describe three key personal values that guide your approach to social work. How have these values influenced your academic, professional, and community choices?"

4. Applications are due April 25, 2025. The recipients will be notified on or about June 27, 2025.
