Online Implementation

You will now be put into a break-out room with a couple of other students to share and discuss your revised paragraphs.

- In your group, take turns to share your paragraphs with your group members. The quickest way to do this is by sharing your screen on Zoom and showing your text to your group. Alternatively, you can also share a Google doc with your group.
- 2. As each student's paragraph is being shared, the group will examine the text carefully and identify parts of the text that are communicated effectively, as well as parts that could be more effective. You should also discuss how the texts could be further improved using the principles of Reader-Based Prose.
- 3. Once all paragraphs have been shared and discussed, the group will create a list of the elements of Reader-Based Prose and compare it to the lists of elements of Writer-Based Prose that you created earlier. It is recommended that you write your list in a shared Google doc.
